

UK Vapefest Camping Conditions

Camping is available both Friday & Saturday night. Some conditions are necessary in addition to those stipulated by the venue. These rules are in place to ensure everyone has a pleasant experience.

YOU MUST READ THESE RULES PRIOR TO CAMPING & BE ABLE TO ACCESS THEM WHILST ON SITE

WEST MIDLANDS SHOWGROUND CONDITIONS

All campers/caravaners must be provided with a written copy of the following conditions and the Hirer shall be responsible for ensuring that the conditions are met:

- No caravan or tent may be sited within 20 meters of the river
- The fence boundary alongside the River Severn must not be removed.
- Although relatively benign for the majority of the year, the River Severn can be subject to flooding for which advance warnings are given by the Environment Agency. Nevertheless the river does present a risk and for this reason no unaccompanied children are allowed on the river bank.
- All vehicles must observe the 5 mph speed limit.
- All vehicles driven must stay on the roads until they reach their camping plot.
- Only the facilities provided on the Showground can be used for slopping out. These are adjacent to the Pontoon and Queens Avenue toilet blocks. Under no circumstances is slopping out to be done in the river: If this is found to have taken place SWMAS reserves the right to use the Damages Bond to cover the fine raised against the Showground.
- Only proper toilets must be used, either those provided at the Showground or portable toilets.
- All users of the site must be conscious of the proximity of the Showground to local residences and keep noise levels to a minimum.
- Personal radios and stereos should be kept at a volume only audible within 20ft and must
- not be played after 2200 hours.
- Noise must not be heard 200 yards from any Showground building. Doors and windows of the building must be kept shut, save for entry and exit.
- All litter is to be disposed of in the bins provided on site.
- Due regard to wildlife should be observed. The

- If you are camping on the Friday, you may arrive from 4pm onwards. The committee need time to prepare before the arrival of any public guests.
- You must not approach vendors who are setting up their pitches.
- Glasses and glass bottles are not permitted. Plastic only please.
- BBQs must be at least 1ft (30cm) above the ground.
- You must not attempt to access any building other than the toilet blocks.
- Observe all the conditions listed in the Showground Special Conditions.
- No generators to be heard after 10pm. Failure to adhere may lead to your removal from the site.
- No music to be heard after 10pm. Failure to adhere may lead to your removal from the site.
- No shouting at the top of your voice whilst everyone else is trying to sleep (no matter how drunk you are). Failure to adhere may lead to your removal from the site.
- Everyone must read these rules prior to camping and should also be able to access them whilst camping.
